



ASSEMBLY BILL (AB)104: DATED JULY 1, 2021  
YUBA COUNTY OFFICE OF EDUCATION Credit Reduction Graduation CONTRACT

Students who were enrolled in their third or fourth year of high school during the 2020-2021 school year, and who are not on track to graduate in four years from all coursework and other requirements adopted by the governing board, that are in addition to the statewide coursework requirements specified in Section 51225.3, are exempt from all coursework over and above the required statewide course work.
