RE: Assembly Bill 104

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Per Assembly Bill 104, the Yuba County Office of Education is required to notify you regarding the ability of families, of an eligible student, to formally request that the school allow their child to repeat a grade level. In order to be eligible for retention, your student must have received deficient grades (a D, F, No Pass) in at least half of their courses during the 2020-2021 school year. Because we track student progress on goals and objectives, and do not provide credits or letter grades in our Yuba County Office of Education programs for students with moderate/severe disabilities, AB 104 is not applicable.
